# Join us for 9 days of prayer to Build Strong Catholic Families!

Imagine the possibilities when the One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church comes together and moves as one body to pray for the building up and strengthening of the Catholic family, the domestic church.

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#### INSTRUCTION GUIDE FOR THE FAMILY NOVENA, 2021

Intended for prayer within families but may also be prayed individually or in groups.

#### What:

Welcome to the Family Novena! In the history of Christianity, novenas have been offered traditionally as nine days of prayer prior to a great feast day, or for any special intention. Novenas are devotions, not sacraments, so they may be prayed by anyone at any time.

The first Christians who prayed a novena were the Apostles themselves when they gathered with the Virgin Mary in the Upper Room after the Ascension. Together, they "watched and prayed" for nine days prior to the coming of the Holy Spirit on the tenth day at Pentecost (Acts, Chapter 2).

#### Why:

We must be <u>clear</u> why we pray this novena. In our current circumstances, there is hardly a greater need for our society than to strengthen the family. We no longer live in an age where the traditional model of family is accepted. The divine plan of the union of husband and wife who beget children in a lifelong, intact, consecrated marriage is under violent attack from every angle. Even the definition of gender is being redefined.

At the core of this problem is a *spiritual* reality, a challenge to the sovereignty of God over life, family, and society. The family itself is an image of the Blessed Trinity. In this novena we call on the power of God to sustain and renew the family, which is the "domestic church", the first place where we learn human values and faith in God.

#### How:

The nine days of prayers in the following pages are carefully structured to provide a complete prayer program on behalf of families and their concerns:

Each day provides a different prayer <u>Intention</u>; a specific <u>Intercession</u> for people; and a petition to a <u>Patron Saint</u> or saints of those for whom we pray. These are followed by the <u>Prayer Offering</u> of a decade of the Holy Rosary where we contemplate a mystery associated with the particular intention or petition of the day. Any family may pray the entire Rosary as per the <u>Deeper Reflection</u> section if so desired. On all nine days, the novena concludes with a <u>Family Novena Prayer</u>.

Ideally, the Family Novena should be prayed within families themselves, with parents taking leadership for the prayer and children participating in various ways. Families are encouraged to supplement each day with additional prayers, which are available in the *Prayers in the Pew: Family Edition* prayer card, the companion to this novena.

The entire novena concludes with the Prayer to the Holy Family by Pope Francis.

The nine days of prayers provide a complete prayer program on behalf of families and their concerns. Any family may pray the entire Rosary as per the Deeper Reflection section if so desired.

In a culture of death, where the value of life is degraded, human beings on both ends of the life spectrum are subject to the greatest injustices. The unborn, the sick, the handicapped, and the elderly have a right to special care from a humane society. We also include in our intercessory prayers all those responsible for guarding or protecting attacks against the vulnerable at any place or stage of life. Send forth Your Spirit, O God to enlighten the minds and transforms the hearts of everyone in public service to come to know the priceless gift of every human life.

#### Petition for Virtue: For Fortitude

May God grant us the Cardinal Virtue of Fortitude, so that we may have strength to bear every trial and the firmness of will not to renounce our defense of life in times of testing. We also pray for those who are bring tempted to give in to the abortion decision and take the easy road. May God grant them Fortitude to resist the temptation of solving their problems through recourse to the injustice of killing the innocent.

#### **Life Program Intention: Special Olympics**

We pray, Loving God, we see You in those living with disabilities and give you thanks for loving parents who welcome and nurture them even in the face of obstacles.
